We require volunteers who are comfortable on skis to assist with our adapted downhill ski program. Volunteers are required to be able to ski a moderate parallel and be comfortable in the snowplough position tethered to the Sit Ski. All training will be done at Searchmont Resort. Volunteers are asked to dedicate one Sunday per month to work with students. A free lift ticket and ski equipment will be provided for the day that you volunteer, so you can ski for the morning and volunteer for the afternoon.

## No Limits Ski Club

No Limits Ski Club operates at Searchmont Resort and is located only 40 km from the twin cities of Sault Ste Marie Ontario and Michigan. No Limits now offers downhill ski lessons and equipment for persons with various disabilities.

## Sit Ski



The sit ski allows persons who have a mobility disability to experience skiing on the mountain.

## Volunteer Guides



Sighted ski guides for blind or partially sighted skiers and ASL interpreter service available.

## Outriggers



Outriggers are used to assist persons who have a single, lower limb amputation to ski.

## Four Track



Four track can accommodate persons who are able to stand and walk, but are unsteady on their feet to learn to ski.

## Out of town Visitors

Visitors can book the equipment and a certified instructor at an hourly rate of \$45 per hour or \$65 for two hours, or for experienced skiers, the equipment can be rented for \$20/hour.

## No Limits Ski Club

The club operates on Sunday afternoons from 1 to 4 PM.

Fees are: \$135.00 for 5 – 1.5 hour lessons and include lift ticket, equipment, helmet, certified CADS instructor and volunteer assistants. Further sessions can be purchased for \$25 per lesson

In many cases, skiers can learn to ski independently (once comfort and skill are achieved). For independent skiers, membership is not required. Skiers can rent No Limits equipment or purchase their own and ski independently.
